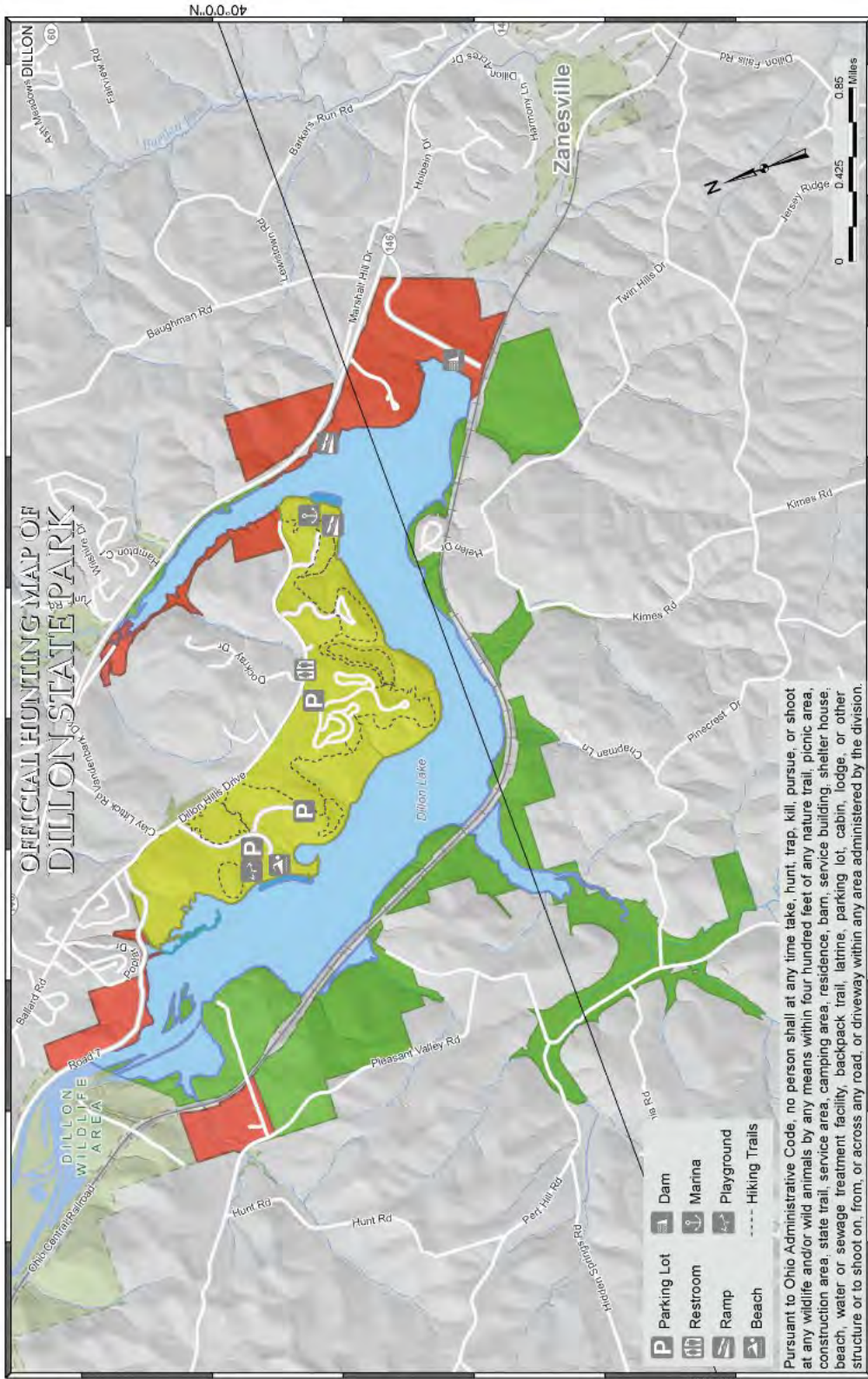

The following rules and information apply:

- Each permittee or transferee may select one (1) youth hunting partner. One non-hunting adult is required to attend the hunt with the youth hunters. Non-hunting adult must accompany the youth hunters to and from the field and be present while the youth hunters are engaged in hunting.
- Permit valid for the permittee or transferee listed on the permit and partner only.
- Permit valid for the date listed on the permit only.
- Permittee and partner are responsible for obtaining necessary permits, license, endorsements, and stamps. Refer to the Ohio Hunting and Trapping Regulations.
- Permit must be carried by the permittee or transferee while in use. Digital copies are sufficient.
- If the permittee cannot participate, the permit may be transferred to another hunter. If the permittee cannot transfer the permit, please contact ODNR using the contact listed above so that an alternate may be assigned.
- Only white-tailed deer may be harvested.
- Permittee may use any firearm legal to harvest deer in Ohio. Refer to the Ohio Hunting and Trapping Regulations.
- Shooting hours are 30 minutes before sunrise to 30 minutes after sunset for the date and location of the hunt.
- The bag limit for this hunt is the same as the county bag limit. Deer management permits may be used for antlerless deer. Antlerless deer harvested on controlled hunts are exempt from the one antlerless deer bag limit on public lands. Antlerless deer harvested during this hunt do not count towards the county or statewide bag limit but do count towards the controlled hunt bag limit of six. Only one antlered deer may be taken statewide during the entire hunting season including during controlled hunts.
- Hunter orange must be worn by permittee and partner. If a hunting blind is used, then hunter orange visible from all directions must be placed on the outside of the blind.
- All other Division rules and regulations apply.

Additional rules and information:

- A post hunt survey will be emailed to the permittee the day following your hunt. Please complete the survey to help us learn how to improve future controlled hunting opportunities.
- Hunters must attend a mandatory pre-hunt meeting at 10:00AM on November 9th, 2024 at the address above. Both the youth permittee and the non-hunting adult must attend the pre-hunt meeting.
- Units will be selected at pre-hunt meeting based on the pick order listed in the unit section on the permit.

Pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code, no person shall at any time take, hunt, trap, kill, pursue, or shoot at any wildlife and/or wild animals by any means within four hundred feet of any nature trail, picnic area, construction area, state trail, service area, camping area, residence, barn, service building, shelter house, beach, water or sewage treatment facility, backpack trail, latrine, parking lot, cabin, lodge, or other structure or to shoot on, from, or across any road, or driveway within any area administered by the division.
