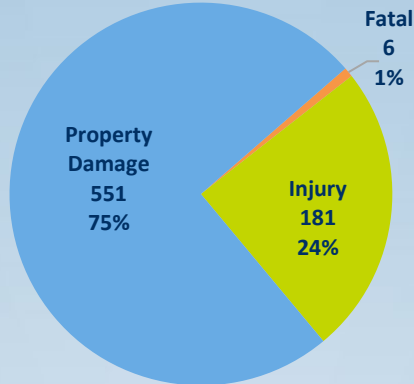




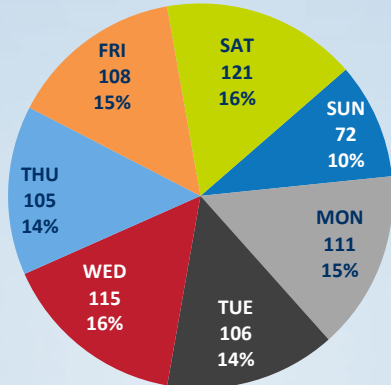

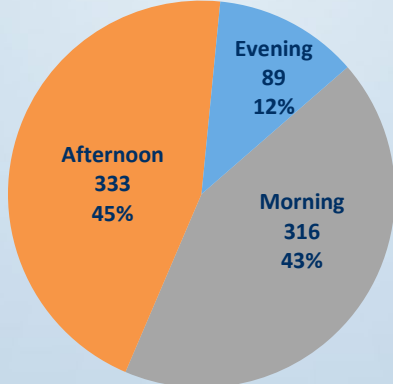
Crashes by Severity

Crashes by Time of Day

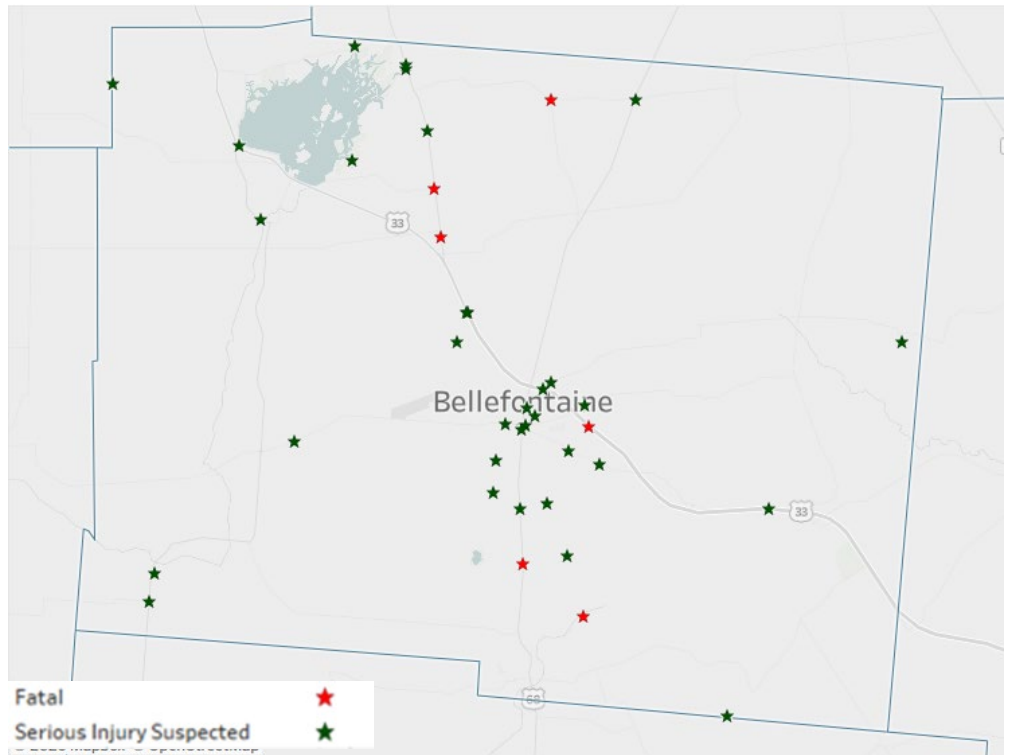

Share the Road with Pedestrians, Bicycles & Motorcycles

- Stay alert and slow down in areas with heavy pedestrian or bicycle activity, especially at crosswalks and intersections.
- Give at least three feet of space when passing bicycles and motorcycles – allow a safe buffer and only pass when it's legal and clear.
- Check blind spots carefully, as pedestrians, bicyclists, and motorcycles can be harder to see than cars.

Stay Focused and Stay in Your Lane

- 26% of Ohio's fatal crashes over the last 5 years were the result of driving off the roadway.
- Driving off the road is the 2nd most common factor in teen crashes in Ohio. Speeding is #1.
- Distraction often causes drivers to drift out of their lane which puts themselves, their passengers, and others on the road in danger.
- Ohio's distracted driving law makes it illegal to use or hold a cell phone in your hand or on your lap while driving.

Ohio's App to Practice Safe Driving Skills



- RoadReady Ohio is a free app for new drivers that helps them log their required 50 hours of driving practice.
- Beginning April 1, 2026, the BMV will require new drivers to submit a detailed log of supervised driving hours with their 50 Hour Affidavit.

Driver Cited After Crash at Dangerous Intersection

The Ohio State Highway Patrol considers US 33 and Stokes Township Road 87 to be a dangerous intersection due to a high number of crashes. On February 11, 2026, the driver of a silver pickup truck was traveling east on Township Road 87 and stopped at the stop sign at US 33. He proceeded into the intersection and directly into the path of an oncoming car which was traveling southeast on US 33 at 55 mph and was not required to stop. The truck hit the side of the car, causing functional damage to the passenger side door. All occupants were wearing seat belts and no serious injuries were reported. The pickup truck driver was cited for Failure to Yield from a Stop Sign.
