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CHANGES AND CLARIFICATIONS TO THE CONTRACT

The following items will be incorporated in the contract as a result of mutual agreement:

1. Wageworks, Inc. will update the addresses of employees every two (2) weeks utilizing information from the commuter choice file that is provided.
2. *Commuter Reimbursement Claims for Undelivered Transit Media:* (a) if delivery addresses are provided by the State and WageWorks mailed the transit media to the designated address with sufficient postage, the State shall be responsible for 100% of the reimbursement costs of such undelivered transit media; or (b) if WageWorks either failed to mail the transit media to the delivery address provided by you or your participant, as applicable, or affixed insufficient postage, then WageWorks will be responsible for 100% of the reimbursement costs. *Address Control:* If the State elected to be solely responsible for providing participant mailing addresses to WageWorks for the fulfillment of participant commuter orders, WageWorks will only accept mailing address information (and any changes thereto) provided by the State
