

OhioBMV Online CDL Renewal



Ohioans may now be eligible to renew their CDL online. The renewal process is easy and efficient and can be performed on a mobile device! Once application is approved, CDL will be mailed to the individual. Helpful Tips

- All online license renewals are for 4 years only.
- Category 1 Medical Certification (Mecert) requires that your medical certificate is up to date before pursuing an online renewal. (You can email an updated copy of your Mecert to cdl@dps.ohio.gov)
- The Ohio BMV does allow you to self-certify your Mecert online if you are certifying Categories 2, 3, and 4 by visiting the BMV website: bmv.ohio.gov
- To be eligible for online renewal for your commercial driver license (CDL) with the Hazmat endorsement, you must have passed a hazmat knowledge test within the last 60 days, and have an unexpired TSA threat assessment on file. TSA threat assessment must be valid for length of the new CDL license.
- The online renewal process does not allow you to change information on your CDL, such as removing or adding any endorsements, changing Mecert categories, or going from Standard to a REAL-ID Compliant license.
