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Commissioner Deters stated that today's order is an appropriate resolution to a challenge specific to central Ohio's rapid data center growth as it allows for and supports new economic development while protecting ratepayers from increased costs associated with increased load on the system and potential stranded cost. He noted that we should continue to be vigilant and deliberate as it relates to data center development and recognize that our entire region within our regional transmission organization is experiencing this same growth creating an unprecedented challenge for state regulators, federal regulators, and our legislators. He further stressed that we must be acutely aware of the present and future risk to reliability and price stability and plan for these rapid changes to our system with a focus on maintaining dependable electric service at the least cost. Stating that failure to do so will put ratepayers at risk and create serious challenges in the future.

Chair French thanked Commissioner Deters and asked if there were any other comments.

Commissioner Conway concurred with Commissioner Deter's comments and thanked all commenters and interested parties who participated in the proceeding. He further noted that the impacts of data center development on central Ohio and the electric system more broadly promises to be massive, which presents us with challenges, but also great opportunities and today's order is one step in the process of meeting the challenges and embracing the opportunities.
