

Rule 3302-24-29 | Temporary military duty license.

(A) The ~~state board~~~~Ohio department~~ of education issues a three-year temporary military duty license, valid in a category, type, and level for which the ~~state board~~~~Ohio department~~ of education issues credentials to an individual who:

(1) Is deemed to be of good moral character; and

(2) Meets the requirements set forth in section [4743.041](#) of the Revised Code.

(B) A license issued under this rule is valid only in the category, type, and level that is substantively comparable to the applicant's valid out-of-state license or certificate and experience pursuant to section [4743.041](#) of the Revised Code. A temporary military duty license may only be issued in a category, type, and level for which the ~~state board~~ ~~Ohio department~~ of education already issues a credential.

(C) The temporary military duty license may be renewed one time, provided the applicant meets the requirements set forth in section [4743.041](#) of the Revised Code at the time of renewal.

(D) Provided the individual has completed all requirements for the applicable license, an individual issued a license under this rule may also apply for and be issued a resident educator license or professional educator license issued under section [3319.22](#) of the Revised Code, or a license in any other category, type, and level issued by the ~~state board~~~~Ohio department~~ of education.
