OBTAINING A HIGHWAY PATROL CRASH REPORT

The Ohio State Highway Patrol (OSHP) maintains complete reports, including witness statements, supplements, scale drawings, etc., for OSHP-investigated crashes.

Information on how to order crash reports and photographs can be obtained via the QR Code below.



You can also go online at <https://statepatrol.ohio.gov/services/> From that page, click on Public Records & Reports Request and follow the instructions to order crash reports and/or photos online. Please wait a minimum of seven business days from the date of the crash before attempting to order a crash report and/or photographs to ensure the availability of the completed initial report. Also, please be aware some crashes require additional investigation beyond the initial report. Additional information resulting from these investigations may not be available until such investigations are complete.
