

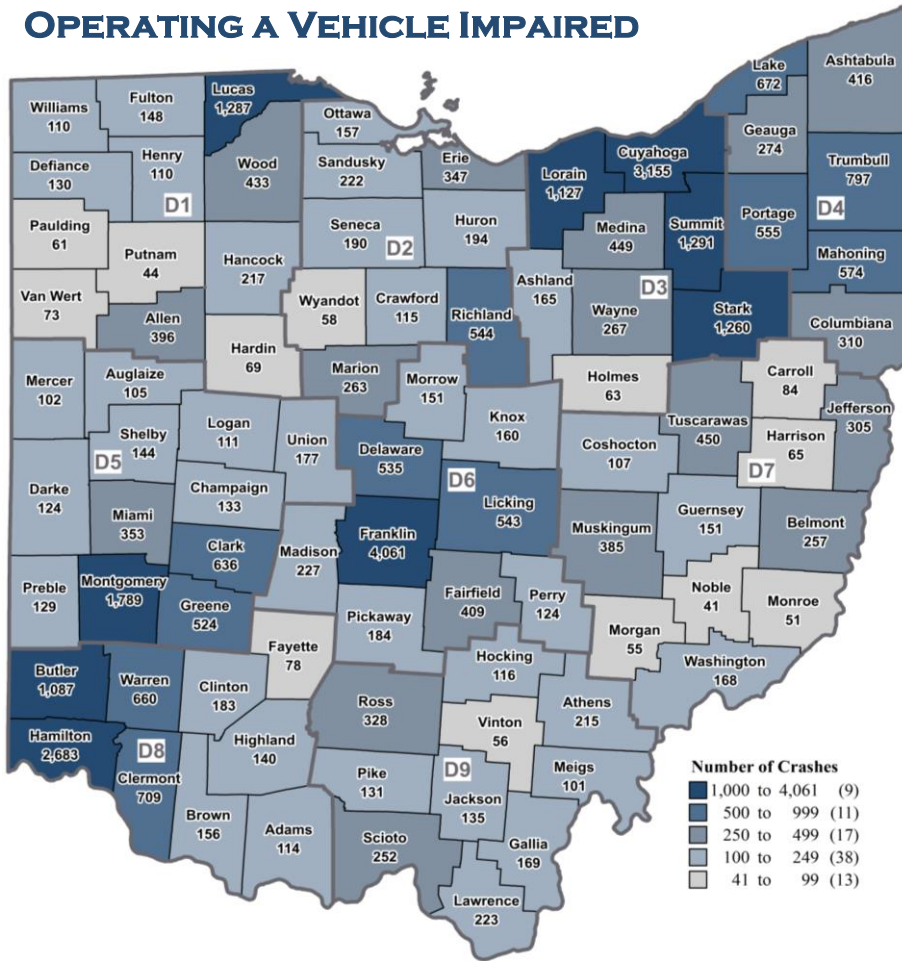

OVI-RELATED CRASHES

- From 2021-2023, 36,919 crashes have occurred on Ohio roadways that involved alcohol and/or drug use by at least one driver or pedestrian. These crashes have resulted in 2,171 deaths (56% of all motor vehicle deaths) and 22,152 injuries (8% of all motor vehicle injuries) during this time period.
- Motorists aged 21-39 were at-fault in 55% of OVI-related crashes in Ohio while underage individuals (15-20) were at-fault in another 6%. Male drivers were at-fault in 71% of OVI-related crashes.
- Franklin (4,061), Cuyahoga (3,155), Hamilton (2,683), and Montgomery (1,789) Counties led the state in OVI-related crashes from 2021-2023. These four counties accounted for nearly one out of every three OVI-related crashes in Ohio (11,688 or 32%).

OSHP OVI CITATIONS

- From 2021-2023, OSHP troopers issued 48,915 OVI citations, an average of more than 16,300 per year. Male drivers received nearly three of every four OVI citations (73%). Nearly one in four individuals (23%) cited for OVI were under the influence of marijuana, another drug, or both.
