QUALIFICATIONS: To receive the owner-occupancy tax reduction, you must own and occupy your home as your principal place of residence (domicile) on January 1 of the year for which you file for the reduction. A homeowner and spouse are entitled to this tax reduction on only one home in Ohio.

CURRENT APPLICATION: If you are applying for the owner-occupancy tax reduction for the first time for next year, check the box for **Application for next Year**.

LATE APPLICATION: If you believe that you also qualified for the owner-occupancy tax reduction for this year, but did not file an application last year, you may file a **Late Application** with the application for next year. When you file a late application for this year, check the late application box on the front of this form.
