The following table outlines how transfer credits will be applied to the Bachelor of Arts in Geography (Human - Urban/Economic Emphasis) degree at University of Cincinnati for students who completed an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree via the Ohio Guaranteed Geography Transfer Pathway. The OGTP designation guarantees the transfer and applicability of credits, but does not guarantee admission to a program. Some bachelor-degree granting programs may be competitive, and students should check with individual institutions for their program admission requirements.
