# Psychology Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts

Effective beginning Academic Year 2023-24 (Last revised November 3, 2023)

The following table outlines how transfer credits will be applied to the Bachelor of Arts in Psychology degree at University of Cincinnati for students who completed an Associate of Arts degree via the Ohio Guaranteed Psychology (AA to BA) Transfer Pathway. The OGTP designation guarantees the transfer and applicability of credits, but does not guarantee admission to a program. Some bachelor-degree granting programs may be competitive, and students should check with individual institutions for their program admission requirements.
