The following table outlines how transfer credits will be applied to the Bachelor of Business Administration degree at Cleveland State University for students who completed an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree via the Ohio Guaranteed Business Transfer Pathway. The OGTP designation guarantees the transfer and applicability of credits, but does not guarantee admission to a program. Some bachelor-degree granting business programs may be competitive, and students should check with individual institutions for their program admission requirements.
