<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> The college requirement is for two Writing Across the Curriculum (WAC) courses, one in the major and one from any discipline. Students may choose the second WAC course from any area. Depending on the course chosen, it may also fulfill a major elective, related, minor, or general elective requirement.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> History majors must complete a minor, a second major, or meet the requirement of 18 hours in "related courses". These courses must be chosen from at least three of the following areas: economics, political science, English and American literature, foreign language, geography, philosophy, sociology, psychology, art history, music history or theatre history. At least 12 of the hours in related courses must be in courses at the 3000 and 4000 levels.
