The OGTP designation guarantees the transfer and applicability of credits, but does not guarantee admission to a program. Some bachelor-degree granting programs may be competitive, and students should check with individual institutions for their program admission requirements.

- ¹ College Algebra (TMM001) is the preferred mathematics course for Psychology majors. However, students transferring with Introductory Statistics (TMM010) will meet the mathematics requirement.
- ² Biology I (OSC003) is recommended because Biology II (OSC004) is required as a part of the remaining coursework to complete the bachelor's degree
- ³ "Under review" and "to be submitted" indicate that the course does not currently carry the statewide course equivalency guarantee. However, the institution is working towards this goal and will act in good faith to ensure the appropriate equivalency is given that counts toward the degree.



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The following additional coursework will be required to complete the Bachelor of Arts in Psychology degree at The University of Toledo after a student has completed their Associate of Arts Ohio Guaranteed Psychology (AA to BA) Transfer Pathway degree.
