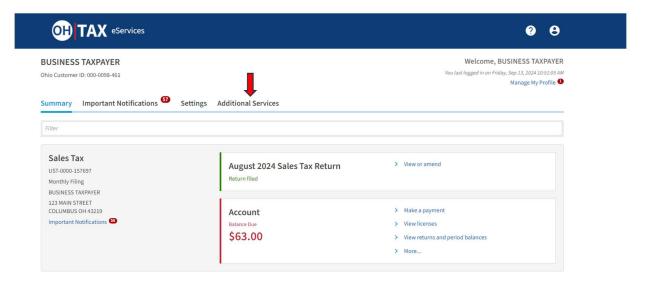


This guide will show you how to update both the legal and accounting address for your business as well as any physical locations associated with a vendor's license. **Please note:** Although this guide displays an example for Sales Tax, the process is the same for other business taxes within OH TAX eServices.

## **Update Address**

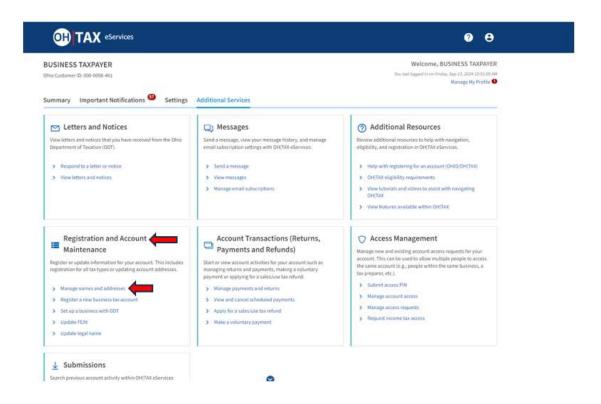
1. Updating the "Legal" and "Account Mailing" addresses.

Select **Additional Services** tab from your dashboard.



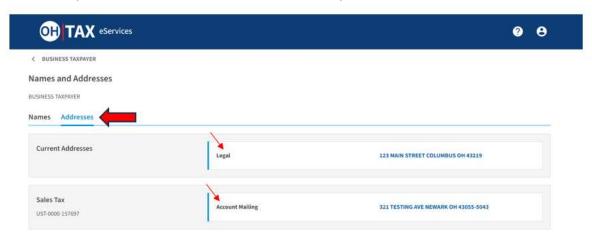


2. Select Manage names and addresses from the Registration and Account Maintenance tile.



## 3. Select Addresses tab.

- "Legal" address refers to the headquarters or primary person's address.
- "Account Mailing" refers to the mailing address where you wish to receive any correspondence or notifications from Ohio Department of Taxation.

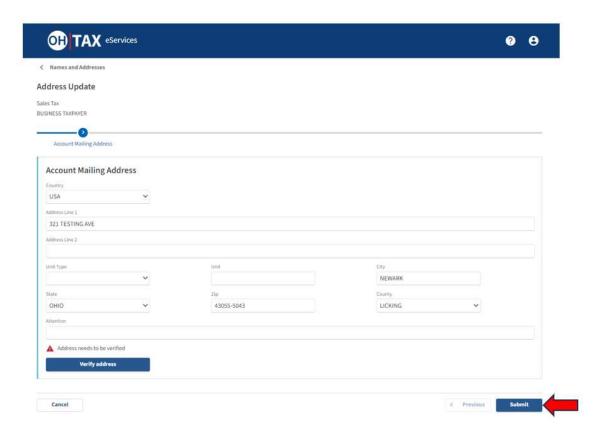




4. Choose the address you wish to update. Select **Update this address**.

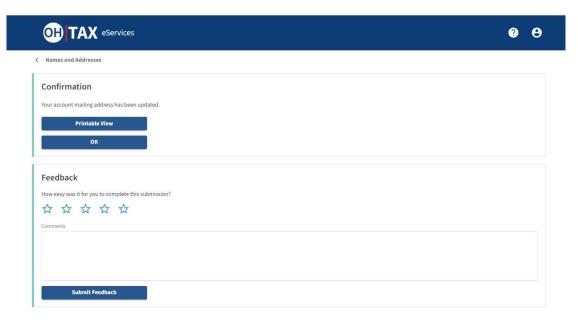


5. Complete the required address information and verify the address using the button at the button. Select **Submit**.





6. Once submitted you will be able to print your confirmation page, showing your account mailing address has been updated.



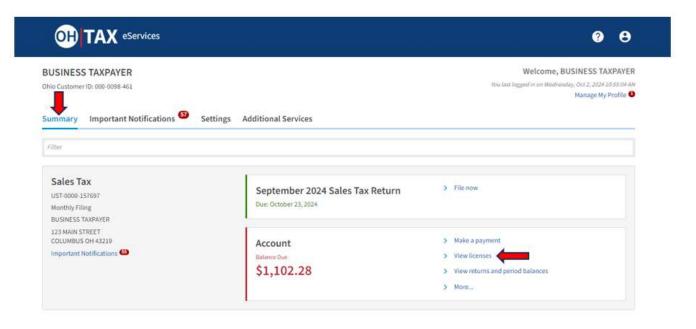
## **Update a Physical Location Address**

1. Physical location refers to the location where you registered your fixed place of business.

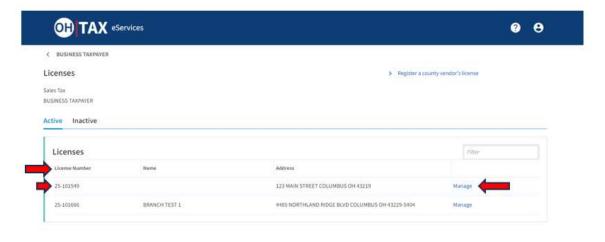
**Please note:** If you move your business to a new county, you must cancel the original vendor's license and obtain a new vendor's license from the new county's auditor.



From the **Summary** page, select **View licenses.** 

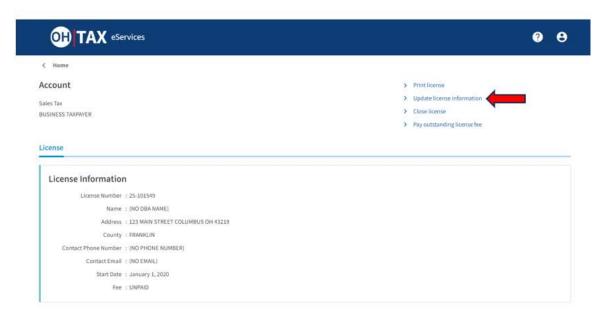


2. Choose the license number that you wish to update and select **Manage**.





3. Select Update license information.



4. Once you have completed all required information for the license location update form, select **Submit**. Once submitted, you will receive a confirmation code, and you will be able to print the confirmation page.
