


IDEA Preschool Special Education Indicator 12 Compliance Calculation Description

Indicator 12: Transition from Part C (Early Intervention) to Part B (Preschool Special Education)

Indicator 12, one of the Department of Education and Workforce's compliance indicators, measures the percentage of children referred by IDEA Part C (Early Intervention) who are found eligible for Part B (Preschool Special Education Services) and who have IEPs developed and implemented by their third birthdays. IDEA requires that 100 % of the children enrolled in Part C (Early Intervention) and found eligible for Part B (Preschool Special Education), have Part B services in place and implemented by each child's third birthday.

Below is a graphic of the calculation used by DCY to determine a district's compliance with Indicator 12 timelines.



Population A (Denominator – Children Referred to Part B from Part C) includes:

- (1) Preschool Transition Conference (PSTC) events reported across two years of data. For example, 7/1/2020-6/30/2022. Prior to FY21, the calculation only included events from one year of data.
- (2) Total number of students reported for the number of PSTC events held where no disability was suspected, and no further evaluation required.

Population B (Children Not Eligible) includes:

- (1) Evaluation Team Report (ETR) events reported where the child was found Not Eligible before their third birthday.

Population C (Numerator - IEP Implemented On Time) includes:

- (1) IIEP events reported where the IEP was implemented before the child's third birthday and by the same district that reported the PSTC.

Population D (Refusals causing delay, or 34CFR 300.301d exceptions) includes:

- (1) Delayed Evaluation where an ETR event occurred after child's third birthday but had reported a valid Non-Compliance ID (i.e. 05 – parental choice, 06 – parent refused consent, 07 – child's health, 08- student incarceration, 09-district in compliance, incorrect/missing data).
- (2) Delayed IEP where an IEP event occurred after child's third birthday but had reported a valid Non-Compliance ID (i.e. 05 – parental choice, 06 – parent refused consent, 07 – child's health, 08- student incarceration, 09-district in compliance, incorrect/missing data).
- (3) Delayed IEP where an IEP event occurred after the child's third birthday, but the PSTC event occurred less than 45 days before the child's third birthday.
- (4) IEP was Not Served, but the PSTC event occurred less than 45 days before the child's third birthday.
- (5) No IEP event, but the PSTC event occurred less than 45 days before the child's third birthday.
- (6) IEP Refusal or Consent Refusal Event which occurred before the IIEP Outcome Begin Date and before the child's third birthday.
- (7) Children who withdrew before their third birthday.

Population E (Late Part C Referrals) includes:

- (1) Children reported in Part C who were determined eligible for early intervention services under Part C less than 90 days before their third birthday.

- a. For a child in this population who also had a PSTC reported, the child will count in the calculation at both the district and state level.
