The agenda for the May 15, 2025, regular board meeting was presented and reviewed.

**Motion #1**

Mr. Cross moved to accept the agenda as amended. Ms. Hofbauer seconded the motion. There was no discussion. The motion passed unanimously.

**MINUTES**

The minutes of the March 7, 2025 board meetings were reviewed.

**Motion #2**

Dr. Mills moved to accept the minutes of the March 7, 2025 board meeting. Ms. Hofbauer seconded the motion. There was no discussion. The motion passed unanimously.

**BOARD PRESIDENT'S COMMENTS**

Ms. Brown welcomed and thanked everyone for attending the meeting. She stated that it is a busy time of year due to spring graduations and the higher volume of licensure applications. She thanked the board staff for their continued teamwork and Mr. Thornton for his leadership as the Executive Director. She thanked Mr. Cross, Mr. Pratt, and the hearing exam proctors for completing an orientation and training for the new practical exam. She stated that the new exam will provide the highest standards for individuals applying for licensure as a hearing aid fitter.

**CHAPTER 119 ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING**

The Board held an administrative hearing pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 119 in the matter of Case No. CO2024-14561. The hearing was called to order at 10:05 a.m. The hearing concluded at 11:53 a.m.

**Quasi-Judicial Deliberations, pursuant to R.C. Chapter 119:**

Case No. 2024-14561

The Board took a recess for quasi-judicial deliberations, pursuant to R.C. Chapter 119 at approximately 11:55 a.m.

The Board returned to Public Session at approximately 1:30 p.m.

**Board Actions – Case No. 2024-14561**

The Board made the following Findings of Fact in the matter of Case No. 2024-14561:

1. In July 2024, Ms. Ryan applied for a speech-language pathology license with the Board. She applied under the "Certification" option since she held the Certificate of Clinical Competency with the American-Speech-Language Hearing Association (ASHA).
2. In August 2024, Ms. Ryan was hired by an employer in the out-patient clinic

setting. She began providing speech-language pathology services in September 2024. Upon employment, Ms. Ryan's employer requested proof that she was licensed by the Board.

3. At the time of hire, Ms. Ryan's licensure application for speech-language pathology was still in pending status with the Board. However, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code section 4753.12(E), Ms. Ryan was authorized to practice in Ohio pending the disposition of her application due to her holding an out-of-state speech-language pathology license from Michigan and certification with ASHA.
4. In November 2024, Ms. Ryan sent her employer a fabricated speech-language pathology licensure wall certificate to avoid potential termination from employment after her employer requested proof of licensure. During the testimony, Ms. Ryan readily admitted to the fabrication.
5. The Board found mitigating circumstances for Ms. Ryan's actions, to wit: that she panicked out of fear of potentially losing her job, the wall certificate she fabricated did not contain another practitioner's license number, she submitted a speech-language pathology application to the Board, and she met the exemption under R.C. section 4753.12(E), which authorized her to practice while her application was in process.

### **Motion #3**

Ms. Hofbauer moved to accept the findings of fact in Case No. CO2024-14561. Mr. Cross seconded the motion, which passed by roll call vote as follows: Ms. Burton: Excused Absence; Mr. White: Excused Absence; Dr. Mills: Yes; Dr. Spangler: Yes; Mr. Cross: Yes; Mr. Griffin: Excused Absence; Ms. Hofbauer: Yes; and Ms. Brown: Yes. Mr. Pratt: Abstained. There was no discussion.

The Board made the following Conclusions of Law in the matter of Case No. CO2024-14561:

Ohio Revised Code Section 4753.10, Disciplinary Actions, provides in part:

In accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code, the Ohio Speech and Hearing Professionals Board may reprimand or place on probation a speech-language pathologist or audiologist or suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue or renew the license of a speech-language pathologist or audiologist. Disciplinary actions may be taken by the board for conduct that may result from but not necessarily be limited to:

ORC § 4753.10 (A)(1) and (3) provides that the Speech and Hearing Professionals Board may reprimand or place on probation a speech-language pathologist or audiologist or suspend, revoke, or, except as provided in division (B) of this section, refuse to issue or renew the license of a speech-language pathologist or audiologist for acts of (1) Fraud, deception, or misrepresentation in obtaining or attempting to obtain a license and (3) Altering a license.

Pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code Rule OAC 4753-3-08 (A), (B) and (C) the Speech and Hearing Professionals Board may reprimand, place on probation, deny, suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue or renew the license of an applicant or a licensee for violation or any provision of Chapter 4753. of the Revised Code and agency-level 4753 of the Administrative Code or any lawful order or rule of the board, and for unprofessional conduct, including but not limited to: (A) Fraud, deception, or misrepresentation in obtaining or attempting to obtain a license or renewal

of a license and (B) Fraud, deception or misrepresentation of a license and (C) Altering a license.

**Motion #4**

Ms. Hofbauer moved to accept the conclusions of law in Case No. CO2024-14561. Dr. Mills seconded the motion, which passed by roll call vote as follows: Ms. Burton: Excused Absence; Mr. White: Excused Absence; Dr. Mills: Yes; Dr. Spangler: Yes; Mr. Cross: Yes; Mr. Griffin: Excused Absence; Ms. Hofbauer: Yes; and Ms. Brown: Yes. Mr. Pratt: Abstained. There was no discussion.

The Board made the following determination in the matter of Case No. CO2024-14561.

Based upon Ms. Ryan's testimony, the State's exhibits and the mitigation presented, the Board is imposing no disciplinary action against her application. The Board shall grant Ms. Ryan a speech-language pathology license and place her license on PROBATION for a period of six years under an active license. Probation allows her to practice speech-language pathology under the following terms and conditions:

1. Ms. Ryan must successfully complete an assessment, evaluation, and any recommendations made by the Ohio Professionals Health Program (OPHP). The Board will make the appropriate referral to OPHP.
2. Ms. Ryan must complete a one year mentorship from a board approved speech-language pathologist mentor.
3. Ms. Ryan must complete four hours of continuing education in the following areas within ninety days upon the effective date of this adjudication order: 1 hour related to documentation; 1 hour related to OPHP ethics; 1 hour related to generations across the workforce; 1 hour related to time management.
4. Ms. Ryan must successfully complete the Board's jurisprudence exam within ninety days upon the effective date of this adjudication order.
5. Ms. Ryan's continuing education hours will be audited for the next three practice bienniums, e.g., 2025-2026, 2027-2028, and 2029-2030.
6. Ms. Ryan's six-year probationary period shall be while she maintains an active license.
7. Ms. Ryan must submit annual performance evaluations upon employment as a speech-language pathologist for six years due within thirty days from completion of the evaluation.
8. Ms. Ryan shall update any change of employment within 30 calendar days in her eLicense portal account and also notify the Board's Investigator.
9. Ms. Ryan shall have no violations of Chapters 4744 and 4753 of the Ohio Revised and Administrative Code Chapters.

10. If in the discretion of the Board, the Board determines that Ms. Ryan has violated any of the terms of this Adjudication Order, the Board shall notify her of the non-compliance via electronic mail per H.B. 33, Ohio Revised Code Section 119.05(B)(1) and (C)(1). Ms. Ryan, within fifteen (15) days of the date of the electronic mail, shall provide the Board a written statement and documentation, if any, to demonstrate that she is in compliance or has corrected any violation of this Adjudication Order. This can be submitted to the Board via electronic mail or facsimile. If Ms. Ryan fails to respond to the Board's notification and/or fails to demonstrate her compliance/corrective action, Ms. Ryan's license shall be immediately suspended until such time, in the Board's discretion, that she is in compliance with the terms stated above.

**Motion #5**

Ms. Hofbauer moved to accept the board's action in Case No. CO2024-14561. Dr. Mills seconded the motion, which passed by roll call vote as follows: Ms. Burton: Excused Absence; Mr. White: Excused Absence; Dr. Mills: Yes; Dr. Spangler: Yes; Mr. Cross: Yes; Mr. Griffin: Excused Absence; Ms. Hofbauer: Yes; and Ms. Brown: Yes. Mr. Pratt: Abstained. There was no discussion.

**ASSISTANT ATTORNEY GENERAL'S REPORT**

Assistant Attorney General Crystal Richie reported that there is no pending litigation or legal matters involving the Board.

**INVESTIGATIONS****A. EXECUTIVE SESSION****Motion #6**

Ms. Hofbauer moved to enter Executive Session for the purpose of discussing investigation of charges or complaints against a licensee, regulated individual, or an applicant for the purpose of disciplinary action pursuant to R.C. §121.22.(G)(1), and which requires that such matters be kept confidential under R.C. §121.22(G)(5). Mr. Cross seconded the motion. which passed by roll call vote as follows: Ms. Burton: Excused Absence; Mr. White: Excused Absence; Dr. Mills: Yes; Dr. Spangler: Yes; Mr. Cross: Yes; Mr. Griffin: Excused Absence; Ms. Hofbauer: Yes; and Ms. Brown: Yes. Mr. Pratt: Abstained. There was no discussion.

The Board entered executive session at: 1:46 p.m. and returned to public session at: 1:56 p.m.

**B. BOARD ACTIONS****New Cases – 5****The First 4 Cases are Grouped:**

**CO2025-1835, CO2025-2476, CO2025-2970, CO2025-3927** – Each of the 4 cases involve speech-language pathologists who practiced more than 15 days under their expired license after the December 31, 2024 renewal deadline. It is their first offense. Individual summaries regarding each of the 4 cases can be found at the end of the Investigative Report.

Accordingly, the Investigative Review Group recommends that the Board approve a Consent Agreement with the following terms and conditions and close the above 4 cases upon the licensees

accepting and completing the terms. If the licensees do not agree to the terms of the Consent Agreement, the Investigative Review Group recommends that the Board authorize a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing be issued:

- Reprimand;
- Complete two additional continuing education hours, in the area of ethics, due 90 days from the effective date of the Consent Agreement. The two hours are not applicable towards the current biennium for renewal;
- Pass the Board's jurisprudence examination due 90 days from the effective date of the Consent Agreement;
- The licensees shall comply with Chapters 4744 and 4753 of the Ohio Revised Code and all other federal and state statutes and rules governing the practice of speech-language pathology.

### **Motion #7**

Ms. Brown moved to accept the Investigative Review Group's recommendation in case numbers CO2025-1835, CO2025-2476, CO2025-2970, CO2025-3927. Ms. Hofbauer seconded the motion. Mr. Pratt abstained. There was no discussion. The motion passed unanimously.

### **CO2025-3677**

This case involves a speech-language pathologist who practiced more than 15 days under her expired license after the December 31, 2024 renewal deadline. Billing occurred; the school district has up to one year to make adjustments. No payments were made out of pocket. The licensee passed her 2023-24 Continuing Education Audit for Practice Under an Expired License. This is her first offense. Her license was issued in June of 2014. The licensee submitted a special request/exception email for the Board to consider.

Accordingly, the Investigative Review Group recommends approving a Non-reportable Consent Agreement based on the extenuating circumstances the licensee presented. The Non-reportable Consent Agreement terms will be as follows; the case will be closed once the terms are complete:

- Complete two additional continuing education hours, in the area of ethics, due 90 days from the effective date of the Non-reportable Consent Agreement. The two hours are not applicable towards the current biennium for renewal;
- Pass the Board's jurisprudence examination due 90 days from the effective date of the Non-reportable Consent Agreement;
- The licensees shall comply with Chapters 4744 and 4753 of the Ohio Revised Code and all other federal and state statutes and rules governing the practice of speech-language pathology.

### **Motion #8**

Ms. Hofbauer moved to accept the Investigative Review Group's recommendation in case number CO2025-3677. Dr. Mills seconded the motion. Mr. Pratt abstained. There was no discussion. The motion passed unanimously.

### **Summaries of the Grouped 4 Cases:**

#### **CO2025-1835**

This case involves a speech-language pathologist who practiced more than 15 days under her expired license after the December 31, 2024 renewal deadline. Medicaid billing occurred; adjustments were made. No payments were made out of pocket. This is her first offense and was her first renewal. Her license was issued in August of 2024.

**CO2025-2476**

This case involves a speech-language pathologist who practiced more than 15 days under her expired license after the December 31, 2024 renewal deadline. Billing did not occur; adjustments were not made. No payments were made out of pocket. The licensee passed her 2023-24 Continuing Education Audit for Practice Under an Expired License. This is her first offense. Her license was issued in June of 2000.

**CO2025-2970**

This case involves a speech-language pathologist who practiced more than 15 days under her expired license after the December 31, 2024 renewal deadline. Billing did not occur; adjustments were not made. No payments were made out of pocket. This is her first offense and was her first renewal. Her license was issued in June of 2024.

**CO2025-3927**

This case involves a speech-language pathologist who practiced more than 15 days under her expired license after the December 31, 2024 renewal deadline. Billing did not occur; adjustments were not made. No payments were made out of pocket. The licensee passed her 2023-24 Continuing Education Audit for Practice Under an Expired License. This is her first offense. Her license was issued in July of 2013.

**Previously Heard Cases**
