Housing units may be in either single (stand-alone) or multi-unit buildings (apartments and condominiums), and include mobile homes, boats, recreational vehicles, etc. Group quarters are excluded.

Frequency

The Census of Population and Housing is conducted every 10 years; estimates may be done annually.

Housing unit counts in this report cover the years 1940-2020, while the estimates are for July 1, 2024.

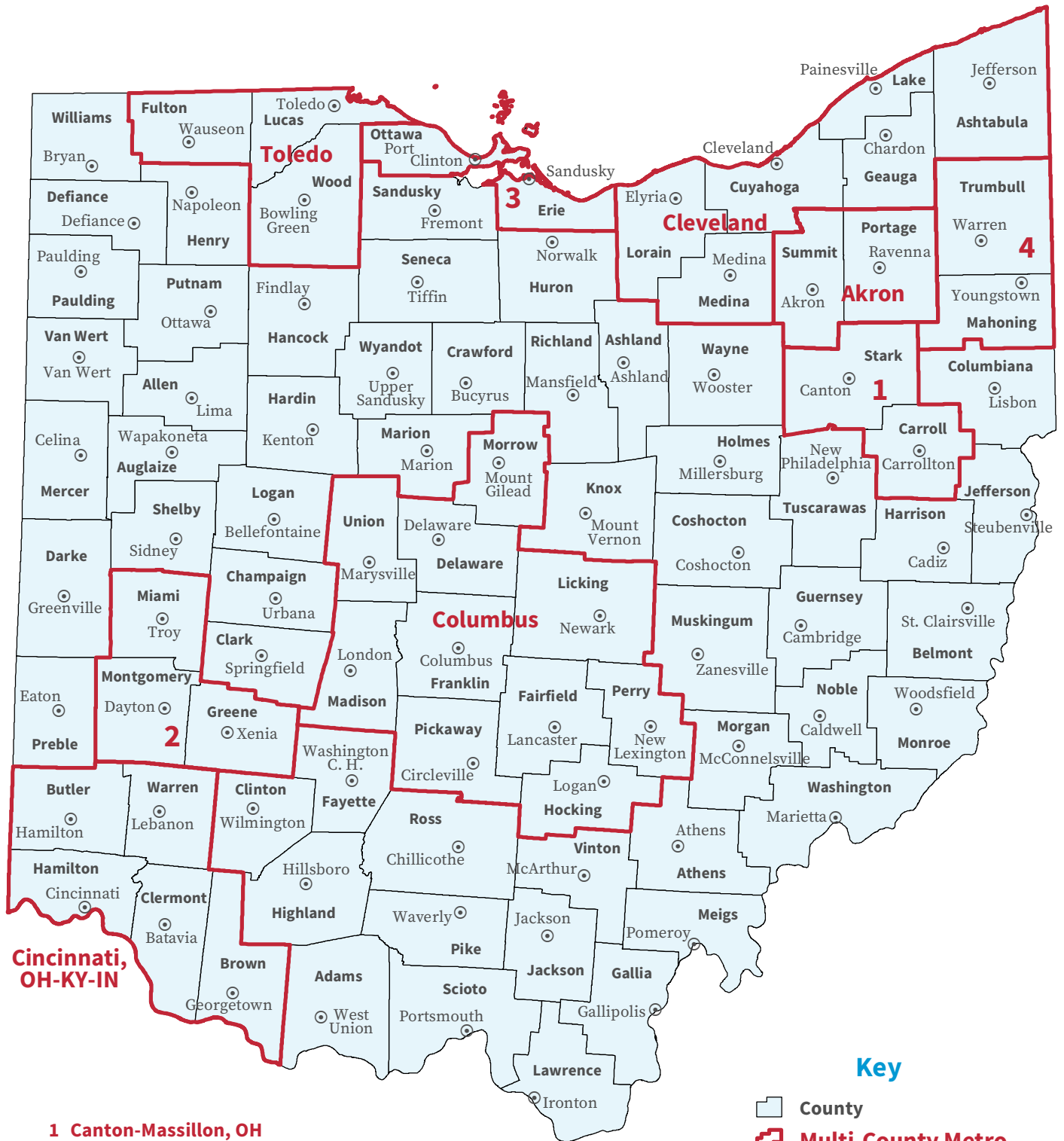
Geographic Area

Ohio Counties, County Seats and Multi-County Metropolitan Areas*



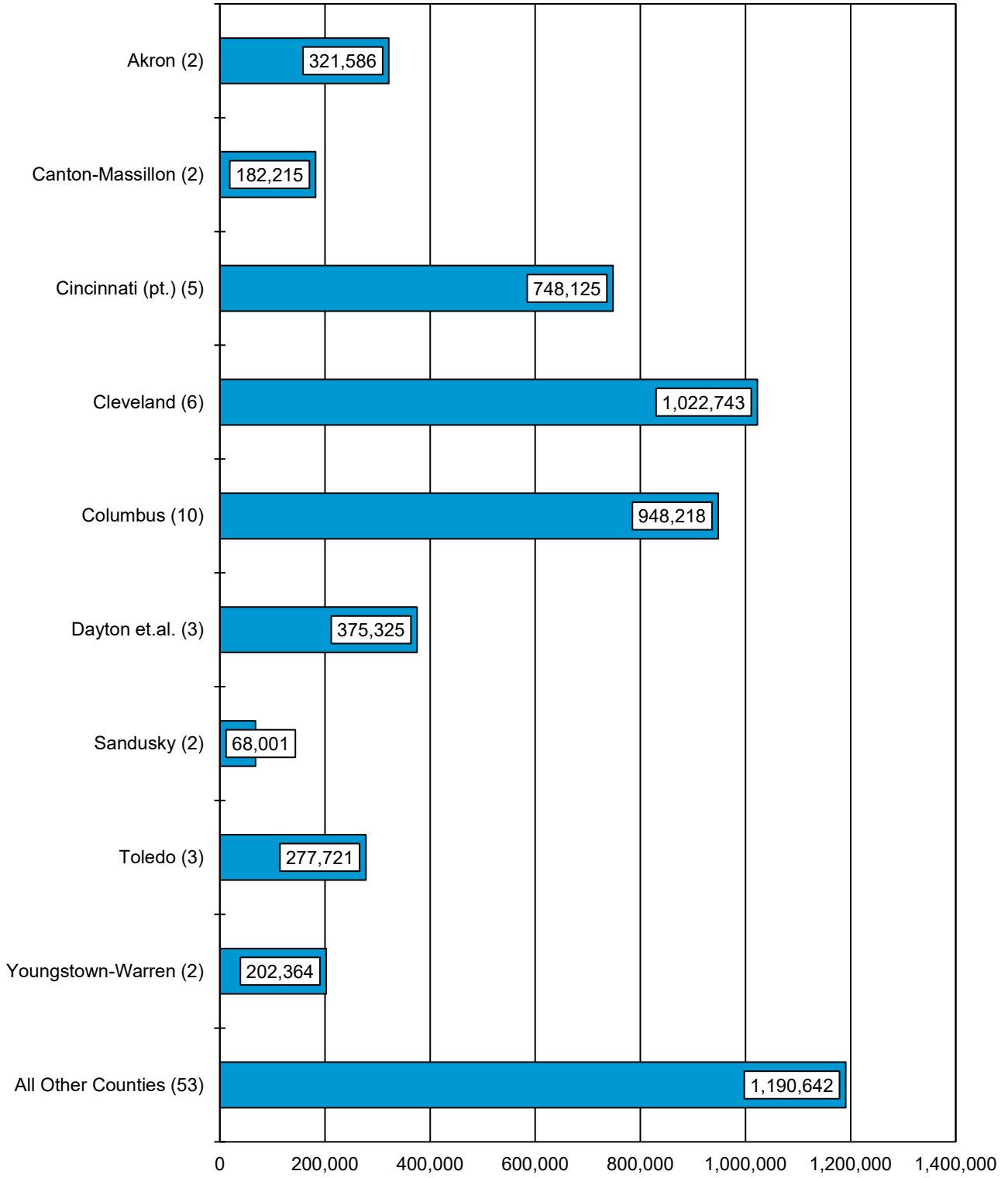
