Re: Notice of Facility Mass Layoff Pursuant to Ohio WARN Act

Dear Heidi Quirion:

This amended notice is being provided pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 4113.31 (the Ohio WARN Act) concerning Senior Resource Connection's ("SRC") previously reported facility mass layoff affecting 190 employees. SRC's original notice identified July 26, 2026, as the closure date. SRC now anticipates that the facility mass layoff will begin on or about June 30, 2026.

The permanent closure will affect SRC operations at the following locations:

222 Salem Avenue, Dayton, Ohio 45406

105 S. Wilkinson Street, Dayton, Ohio 45402

This amended notice reflects SRC's revision to the originally anticipated closure date of July 26, 2026. At the time the initial notice was issued, SRC had not yet finalized whether its services would be transferred. Throughout this period, SRC's decisions depended on whether other organizations would be able to assume those services. Accordingly, SRC was unable to announce these changes until the transfers were confirmed. SRC now understands that services will transfer to other organizations effective June 30, 2026, at which time SRC's operations will begin to close.

SRC anticipates that the mass layoff will begin on June 30, 2026, affecting 160 employees, with an additional 5 employees affected on July 10, 2026, and 4 employees affected on July 20, 2026.

As stated in the initial notice, after recognizing SRC's financial condition, the Board worked to reduce the impact of closure by engaging a financial specialist, prioritizing payroll and client services, exploring a potential merger or acquisition, coordinating with partner agencies to maintain services for seniors, and seeking transition opportunities for affected employees. Those efforts ultimately could not overcome the organization's short-term debt and continuing financial losses.

This notice is being provided in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 4113.31 (Ohio WARN Act).

Senior Resource Connection (“SRC”) has made the difficult decision to cease operations and dissolve the business. As a result, SRC will permanently close its operations at the following locations:

222 Salem Avenue, Dayton, Ohio 45406

105 S. Wilkenson Street, Dayton, Ohio 45402

The layoffs are expected to occur on or about July 26, 2026. This action will result in the permanent layoff of 190 employees at this location.
